

ECHO LAKE STATE PARK

Echo Lake State Park is a great place to take the family for a swim and picnic. Several hiking trails originate in the park including a scenic trail around the lake and others which lead to **Cathedral Ledge State Park** where views of the Saco River Valley are spectacular.

Opening date for Echo Lake State Park is Saturday, June 13th at 9:00AM. Current hours are 9:00AM to 6:00PM

Advanced reservations are required. Reservations are available <u>HERE ></u> and scroll to Echo Lake. As guests with reservations leave the park during the day, we will allow in

the same number of people that left and those drive-ins will be exact change cash only. Adults 12 and up are \$4.00. Children 6-11 are \$2.00. Five and under are free. Make sure to check the specific instructions below so you can enjoy your time at Echo Lake State Park.



- Change and credit card services are not available.
- Be aware the Conway Police Department is enforcing the "No Parking" signs on Old Westside Rd.
- For guests with Park Plates, season passes, NH residents over 65, active military, retired NH military there will be spaces put aside. The State encourages reservations for these groups but not required.
- Guests will be asked screening questions prior to admission.
- The bathhouse is one way from the beach side. Both bathrooms are gender neutral and are single person or family use only. Please wear your mask and footwear and wait until a room is available and please lock the door behind you. Signage is in place. Changing rooms are unavailable.
- Picnic tables are limited and distanced to protect our guests. Only one table per group is allowed.
 Please do not move tables.
- Beach use is allowed. Please distance yourself from other guests. There is a marked opening for travel to
 and from the beach. Please do not occupy this path and please keep the walking path between the beach
 and picnic area clear for walking guests and emergency response.
- Echo Lake Trail is one way from the right of the picnic area and around the lake.
- Reminder: This is a carry in / carry out park. Please take your trash with you. The picnic area and beach are smoke free. No glass allowed.
- Bathrooms close as 5:30PM. Gates are locked at 6:00PM.
- The Cathedral Ledge gate is closed and currently no opening date is scheduled. Visitors can walk or bike up the road or hike the trails from Echo Lake to the summit.
- Cathedral Ledge Rd. is open to the gate. Please park off the paved surface.
- NH State Parks self-fund and no tax dollars are used in its operations. Funding comes from entry fees,
 off road vehicles and Park Plate registrations, donations and grants. Please consider donating at the
 Iron Rangers (donation points) within the parks.
